#### **About the Course**

#### **Background**

According to UN's estimations, by 2025, 83% of the expected global population (8.5 billion) will be living in developing countries. Yet, the capacity of available resources and technologies to satisfy the demands of this growing population for food and other agricultural commodities remains uncertain.

Major adjustments are needed in agricultural, environmental and macroeconomic policy, at both national and international levels, to create the conditions for sustainable agriculture and rural development. There is a continuous exit of small farmers from business, due to the limitation of land and water. Today's farmers need to make the transition from being simple producers to becoming managers of an agricultural enterprise, armed with the latest technologies and know-how, as well as an understanding of the market.

These adjustments will need to encompass education initiatives, utilization of economic incentives and the development of appropriate and new technologies, thus ensuring stable supplies of nutritionally adequate food, access to those supplies by vulnerable groups, and production for markets; employment and income generation to alleviate poverty; and natural resource management and environmental protection. Agricultural diversification, coupled with intensive Research and Development and effective up-to-date extension services for rural farms, will prevent the transformation of additional farming lands for non-agricultural use and keep farmers and rural professions in business.

Taking into account current trends, Israel is ready to share its rich experience in the promotion and enhancement of rural development and sustainable agriculture.

#### Aims

The development model of Israel's agricultural and rural sector can be adapted in other regions. This training program intends to convey and share with participants the vision, strategies and holistic management that Israel has implemented in the process of development of the sector, as well as create a framework for discussion in order to encourage participants to identify lines of action for the revitalization of the agricultural sector in their respective countries.

#### **Main Subjects**

The training will include professional lectures and visits on the following subjects:

- National development policies & strategies for agricultural and rural development in Israel
- The linkage between research, extension and agricultural production
- Supporting institutions for agriculture production and marketing
- Implementation of intensive agriculture and applied technologies
- Innovation and entrepreneurship in the rural sector
- Sustainable agriculture, environment and the rural community

#### **Application**

#### **Application Requirements**

The course is geared towards professional's involved in development, planning and implementation of national and regional projects in the agricultural sector and rural areas in their respective countries. Candidates should hold an academic degree in related disciplines and at least two years of professional work experience in related fields. A full command of English is required.

#### **General Information**

#### **Arrival and Departure**

Arrival date: January 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2017 Opening date: January 24<sup>th</sup>, 2017 Closing date: February 8<sup>th</sup>, 2017 Departure date: February 9<sup>th</sup>, 2017

Participants must arrive at the training center on the arrival date, and leave on the departure date. Early arrivals/late departures if required, must be arranged by the participants themselves, directly with the hotel/center, and must be paid for by the participant him/herself.

#### **Location and Accommodation**

The course will be held at MASHAV's International Agricultural Training Center - **MATC**. The Center is located in Kibbutz Hotel Shefayim, situated 20 km north of Tel Aviv near the coastal city of Netanya.

**MASHAV** awards a limited number of scholarships. The scholarship covers the cost of the training program including lectures and field visits, full board accommodation in double rooms (two participants per room), health insurance (see below) and transfers to and from the airport. Airfares and daily allowance are <u>not</u> included in the scholarship.

#### **Health Services**

Medical insurance covers medical services and hospitalization in case of emergency. It does not cover the treatment of chronic diseases, specific medications taken by the participant on a regular basis, dental care and eyeglasses. Health authorities recommend that visitors to Israel make sure they have been inoculated against tetanus in the last ten years. Medical insurance is subject to the full binding policy conditions, participants are responsible for all other expenses.
